





Using Prepositional Phrases to Express Location

Unidad 4 Etapa 1

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Several different prepositional phrases can be used to talk about the location of people, things, events, etc.

Use **de** when the preposition is followed by a **specific location**.

Remember: **de** + **el** = **del**

Also remember that the verb **ESTAR** is used to talk about location.




Cerca de = near

La librería **está cerca de** la panadería.
*The book store is **near the** bread bakery.*

Detrás de = behind

La motocicleta **está detrás del** autobús.
*The motorcycle is **behind the** bus.*



Delante de = in front of

El tren está **delante de** la estación de tren.

*The train is **in front of** the train station.*

Al lado de = beside

El policía está **al lado del** banco.

*The policeman is **beside** the bank.*





A la izquierda de = to the left of



La carnicería está a la izquierda de la panadería.

The butcher's shop is to the left of the bread store.

Entre = between

La joyería está entre la papelería y la pastelería.

The jewelry store is between the stationery store and the pastry shop.



A la derecha de = to the right of

La panadería está a la derecha de la carnicería.
The bakery is to the right of the butcher's shop.

Lejos = far

El aeropuerto está lejos.
The airport is far.

lejos de = far from

El centro comercial está lejos de la librería.
The mall is far from the library.
