Expressing Obligation with "HAY QUE" and "TENER QUE"

To talk about things someone must do, you can use two different phrases that that express obligation.

1. Use a conjugation of TENER in the personal phrase: Tener Que + infinitive verb (to have to...) if there <u>is</u> a specific subject.

Ex. "Mi madre tiene que trabajar." My mom has to work (my mom is the specific subject)

2. Use the impersonal phrases:
Hay Que + infinitive verb (one should/must...) if there is <u>no</u> specific subject.

* Do not conjugate

Ex. "Hay que trabajar." One should work. It is important to work. (There is no specific subject)
