


Acabar de + Infinitive Verb

- ⇒ *acabo* de (I just)
- ⇒ *acabas* de (You just)
- ⇒ *acaba* de (he, she, you just)

- ⇒ *acabamos* de (we just)
- ⇒ *acabáis* de (you just)
- ⇒ *acaban* de (they, you just)

+ infinitive

Acabo de **comprar** unos zapatos.
