

You learned that the u in jugar sometimes changes to ue. When you use the verb pensar (to think, to plan), the e in it's stem sometimes changes to ie. Pensar means to plan only when followed by an infinitive.

STEM: PENS- ENDING: -AR
The "E" changes to "IE"

Pensar = to think, to plan

Singular	Plural
1.pienso	1.pensamos
2.piensas	2.pensáis
3.piensa	3.piensan

Notice that the nosotros(as) and the vosotros(as) do not require a stem change.

*Pensar + que... = to think that

*Pensar + en = to think about

Él piensa que tú eres loco. He thinks that you are crazy.

> Nosotros pensamos en ti. We think about you.



Conjugated Verbs

¿Piensas jugar en el equipo de baloncesto? Do you plan to play on the basketball team?

¿Piensas pasar un rato con tu mamá el domingo?

Do you plan to spend time with your mom on Sunday?
