

You learned that the **u** in **jugar** sometimes changes to **ue**. When you use the verb **pensar** (to think, to plan), the **e** in its **stem** sometimes changes to **ie**. **Pensar** means to plan only when followed by an infinitive.

STEM: PENS- **ENDING: -AR**

The **"E"** changes to **"IE"**



Pensar = to think, to plan

| Singular | Plural |
|--------------------|---------------------|
| 1. pi enso | 1. pen samos |
| 2. pi ensas | 2. pen sáis |
| 3. pi ensa | 3. pi ensan |

Notice that the nosotros(as) and the vosotros(as) do not require a stem change.

* **Pensar** + **que...** = to think that

* **Pensar** + **en** = to think about

Él piensa **que** tú eres loco.
He thinks **that** you are crazy.

Nosotros pensamos **en** ti.
We think **about** you.

Do you plan to play on the basketball team?

¿**Piensas pasar** un rato con tu mamá el
domingo?
Do you plan to spend time with your mom on
Sunday?
