Phrases for Making Comparisons

A. These phrases are used to compare things with an **adjective between the comparing words (*Notice that “que” and “como” do not have accents because they are not interrogative words*):**

1. **más . . . que** = *more . . . than*

El béisbol es **más interesante que** el fútbol.
Baseball is more interesting than soccer.

2. **menos . . . que** = *less . . . than*

Josh es **menos guapo que** Nick.
Josh is less good-looking than Nick.

3. **tan . . . como** = *as . . . as*

Daniel es **tan gordo como** su gato.
Daniel is as fat as his cat.

B. These phrases are also used to compare things *without* the adjective between them:

1. **más que** = *more than*

Me gusta el perro de Josh **más que** él.
*I like Josh's dog **more than** (I like) him.*

2. **menos que** = *less than*

Me gusta correr **menos que** comer.
*I like to run **less than** (I like) to eat.*

3. **tanto como** = *as much as (singular)*

A él le gusta jugar al fútbol **tanto como** al béisbol.
*He likes to play soccer **as much as** (he likes to play) baseball.*

4. **tantos como** = *as many as (plural)*

Ella come **tantos dulces como** su amiga.
*She eats **as many sweets as** her friend.*

Me gustan los burritos **tantos como** las enchiladas.

*I like burritos **as much as** (I like) enchiladas.*

C. When you talk about numbers, you must use **más de or **menos de** (not “que”).**

1. La clase se termina en **más de** dos o tres minutos.

*The class ends in **more than** two or three minutes.*

Tienes que leer por **más de** diez minutos.

*You have to read for **more than** ten minutes.*

2. La película empieza en **menos de** cinco minutos.

*The movie starts in **less than** five minutes.*

D. Here are a few more words to compare things:
